### Resolution

*“The Faculty of Invisibility,*

*“Recalling* its previous endeavors to enter and interfere with the realm of institutionalization, in particular in the productions *The Speech* (2006), *Communiqué* (2007), *The Invitation* (2008), and *Resignation* (2008), as well as the ongoing communication amongst its tutors and associates,

*“Responding* to the invitations of the Shedhalle Zürich and Transmission Gallery Glasgow, *acknowledging* the present and future support of Künstlerhaus Büchsenhausen and Flutgraben e.V. and *emphazising* the previous support of the Jan van Eyck Academie and Het Blauwe Huis,

*“Expressing* its deep interest to follow and comprehend the developments at the bases of the contemporary art institutions, and, to that end, subjecting the partnering institutions to the Faculty’s work,

*“Recalling* the relevant principles contained in the Faculty of Invisibility to exemplarily transgress formats of public organization in order to make them available and employ them for another performative use,

*“Commending* to actively investigate the forces at play in the constituting formats of the institution as a possible place of the political,

*“Suggesting*, contrary to proposing a collaboration or a series of talks, to work on a modality of production that is carried out by a number of persons *on behalf of* the Faculty of Invisibility, thus suspending the production of individual work and establishing an empty place by being there as if not being there,

*“Referring* to such figures as the helper, who by means of his ceaseless activity remains without an œuvre,

*“Encourages* the creation of such a position within the Jan van Eyck Academie,

*“Reaffirming* its commitment to fully respond to the demands and requirements inherent to the research institution, including internal as well as external demands to be made of the intermediary,

“*Commending* the active role and dedication of the personnel of JVE, notably of its advising and fellow researchers, and *expressing* its strong appreciation of associated parties willing to instigate further exchange and *underlining* the necessity that the Faculty of Invisibility have at its disposal all necessary means and equipment to extend and facilitate this mandate,

“1. *Decides* to apply to a researcher’s position at the Jan van Eyck Academie to be executed *on behalf of* the Faculty of Invisibility by changing intermediaries;

“2. *Requests* the Jan van Eyck Academie to extend an empty place at the Jan van Eyck’s Fine Art Department for the period of one year without amendment as presented in the attached letter dated 13 September to the Faculty of Invisibility in this endeavor;

“3. *Commends* the positive decision of the Jan Van Eyck to establish a new strategic environment located in the institution, and welcomes the expansion of coordinated activities between JVE and the Faculty of Invisibility and its partners and encourages further enhancement of this cooperation;

“4. *Calls upon* all parties and extends the mandate on the changing intermediary to instigate the close exchange amongst the engaged institutional parties and to invest into the speculative space of this endeavor;

“5. *Urges* all parties to cooperate fully with the intermediary, as well as *encourages* the intermediary to increase the number of engaged parties throughout his mandate;

“6. *Guarantees* the responsible conduction of this process through the on behalf of the Faculty undersigned applicants, including transparency of the Faculty’s endeavor and the courier’s activities through reports and internal communication to the Editorial Board and other institutional bodies;

“7. *Suggests* to foster the engagement of fellow and advising researchers in acts of translations initiated by the researcher’s position held *on behalf of* the Faculty, including cooperations with the aligned parties;

“8. *Welcomes* in this regard receiving as soon as possible the conclusions of the Selection Committee of the JVE Academie, including the structure, assets and requirements that will be conducted, as referred to in the attached Faculty of Invisibility’s letter of 13 September 2009, during the coming months, in an effort to ensure, along with good practice, that the mission’s assets and resources are configured most appropriately to fulfill its mandated tasks;

“9. *Stresses* the importance of, and the need to achieve, a comprehensive, just and lasting development of new formats to research and think institutionalization in the economic, artistic and conceptual realm of institutions in Europe;

“10. *Decides*, according to the founding principles of the Faculty of Invisibility,

to remain actively seized of the matter.
